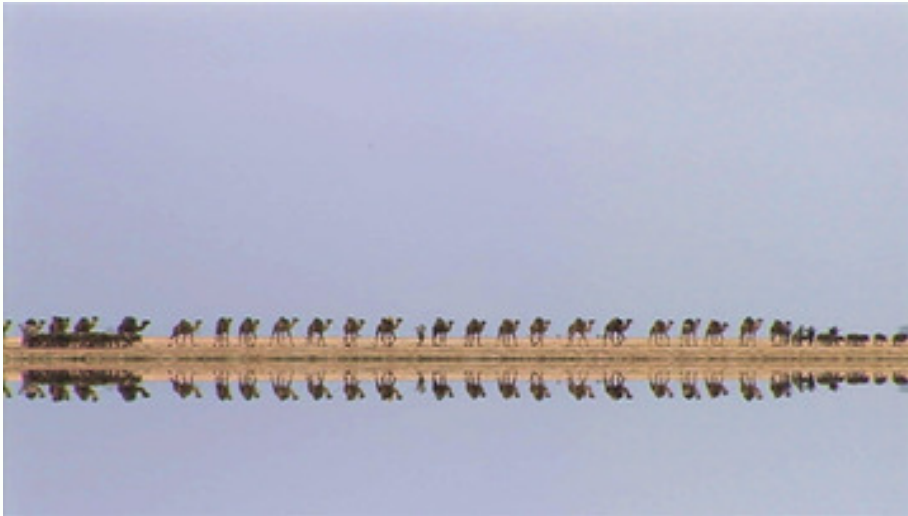


SYNOPSIS

Valerie Browning knows what it means to live in one of the most inhospitable and impoverished regions in the world. The 60-year-old is at home in the Afar region of Ethiopia - and that's the hottest desert in the world. Mile-long hikes in 50° heat are part of her everyday life. The Carinthian Erfried Malle has worked in the region for years with his aid organisation «SONNE international» (Support Organisation for Non-formal Needed Education), working closely with Valerie Browning's organisation APDA (Afar Pastoralist Development Association). Their projects cover a wide spread: They dig water reservoirs, purposefully replenish livestock after droughts and train health workers, who carry out vaccination campaigns or assist at births.
