Their former members look back on those days, when they went on expeditions, researched its required medical foundations and put Alpine sponsoring on its way. The year 2008 also sees the 30th anniversary of the first ascent of Mount Everest by Austrians. On 3 May 1978, Wolfgang Nairz, Robert Schauer and Horst Bergmann, together with Ang Phu, stood on the summit of the highest mountain on Earth. Only 5 days before Messner and Habeler changed the face of professional alpinism forever.
