Dark green, wooded mountainsides, bizarre rock formations and the blinding white of eternal snow and ice: nine Austrian federal states, nine mountains, nine summits. This documentary attains the heights. Stunning cineflex views of Austria's Alps alternate with images of climbers rising through spectacular landscapes. And it's more. Austrian celebrities from all walks of life do what celebrities should do - celebrate: the mountains' magic, their challenge, their peace, their exhilaration and inspiration - and sometimes their terror. Simultaneously, two of the world's best mountain climbers, a man and a woman, set out to conquer all nine peaks in nine days. It has never been done before. The view from the sky reveals the different world each mountain is the centre of (even the state of Vienna's, only 300 meters high!). Each is a unique ecosystem separated by bands of altitude. Those who know the mountains best - mountain innkeepers, rescue teams, dairymaids - toss in a grain of realism . . . Austria's peaks from zero to zenith and back again, with thrills, emotion, achievement and invigorating energy.
